Park strips are the area between the curb and the sidewalk. By Mapleton City Code, you are required to plant one tree in the park strip for every thirty feet of frontage. The city holds a bond of \$100 per tree, which will be released once the trees have been planted and inspected, to ensure they meet the City Code requirements. All trees must be a minimum of one inch caliper or greater (one inch is recommended due to better survivability rate).

Any of the deciduous trees listed above are allowed in park strips. Conifers are not approved for park strip areas.
