

Pressurized Irrigation (P.I.)

As the summer heats up the demand on the Pressurized Irrigation System is extremely high. We need all users to observe the odd, even, watering schedule and to vary watering times. You could try watering in the afternoon and evening hours, instead of the morning. Also, please be aware that the pressurized irrigation is only to be used to water landscaping. It is against the City Code for the P.I. water to be used to water fields, orchards, or any other agricultural use. The City relies on your cooperation to make the P.I. System work efficiently. As a reminder the voluntary watering schedule is listed below:

EVEN NUMBERED HOUSES:

Monday, Wednesday and Friday

ODD NUMBERED HOUSES:

Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday
