



Water Quality

Mapleton City is constantly trying to upgrade our water system. Working with limited funds, we started replacing several water mains in the City last year that are over 50 to 60 years old and will continue this year with the project to upgrade several other areas in town.

Our constant goal is to provide you with a safe and dependable supply of drinking water. We are continually working to improve the water treatment process and protect our water resources. We are committed to ensuring the quality of your water.

Mapleton City routinely monitors for constituents in our drinking water in accordance with the Federal and Utah State laws. Every month we are required to take water samples and submit them to the Utah State Division of Drinking Water.

If there is ever an issue with contaminants in a water sample we are required by law to notify the public in a timely manner. If you have any questions regarding water quality, please contact the Mapleton City Public Works Department at 801-489-6253.
