

## Mayor's Message

### Pressurized Secondary Water Master Plan

At the last City Council Meeting the city's secondary water (Pressurized Irrigation – PI) Master Plan was adopted. It provides an outline of the phased program to expand the pressurized water system throughout the city in order to meet water conservation standards.

The construction of the first phase will commence and continue throughout this winter. The first phase will concentrate on reconstructing a holding pond on the existing site that lies to the east of Aspen Drive, between 400 North and Dogwood Drive. New connections will extend to homes located between Maple and 400 North and Main Street to 1200 East.

The second phase will expand the system to all properties on the east side of Main Street located between 1700 North southward to 1600 South. The third phase will take in the remainder of the city west of Main Street from 800 North to 1600 South, including all properties to the west of Highway 89.

The commencement of phases two and three will depend upon the availability of grants from the Central Utah Water Conservancy District who are funding 65% of the cost of the total project and for this reason it makes it difficult for me to be specific about the timetable at this point. The completed project will include meter installation throughout the city in order to meet the State Departments target to reduce overall water consumption by 25%. 
### New Monthly Utility Charge – South Utah Valley Solid Waste District

Included on this month's utility bill is an increased \$1.75 charge for garbage collection to cover an additional tipping charge fee imposed on all cities by the South Utah Valley Solid Waste District. The Solid Waste District has improved and upgraded recycling facilities at their landfill sites and effective July 1<sup>st</sup> this year imposed a \$1 a month assessment on each property.

Another charge has also been imposed on Allied Waste, the City's garbage collection contractor, as a result of increases in tipping fees that translates into a .50¢ per month garbage collection increase.

To recover the full years charges, from July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 to June 30, 2011 a further .25¢ charge has been added that can hopefully be dropped from July 1, 2011, assuming the Solid Waste District's charge remains at its current level.

This increase is much regretted but the City Council has no option other than to pass along this charge.


