**BURN PERMIT**  
**OPEN BURN WINDOW APRIL 1, 2014 TO MAY 31, 2014**

The following guidelines apply for open burning in the incorporated limits of Mapleton City.

1. A written permit must be obtained from the Mapleton City Office prior to the start of the burn. This permit is valid only on the date issued. Office hours are 8:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday & 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Friday.
2. Open burning is permissible only if Utah County has determined the Clearing Index is satisfactory on the date the permit is issued.
3. Applicant for such permit must be in legal control of the lot where the burning is to be done.
4. Open burning shall not be permitted when there is an appreciable wind. If a burn permit has been issued and the wind becomes a factor, applicant is responsible to not burn or put the fire out.
5. Such burning is done at a distance of more than 50 feet from any building, structure or other combustible waste matter.
6. Materials to be burned should be organized into piles no larger than 4 feet square. The area surrounding these piles must be clear of combustible materials that could be ignited.
7. Flammable or combustible liquids cannot be used to start or maintain a fire. Old tires cannot be used as a fuel source.
8. No petroleum or plastic products, cardboard or scrap lumber may be burned at any time.
9. A garden hose, water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment must be on hand and a competent person (age 16 or older) is in constant attendance until all fire has been extinguished.
10. Fire must be completely extinguished before dark.

We would ask that if you are planning to burn that you would be considerate of your neighbors. Be aware of smoke drifting towards and in to your neighbor's homes. If the fire or police department is asked to respond, and if it is determined that the fire is a nuisance, the fire department will extinguish the fire. **Persons who have been issued a burn permit are liable for any damage caused by their fire.**

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**AGRICULTURAL BURN PERMIT  
DITCH BANK, FENCE LINE AND CANAL**

The following guidelines apply for agricultural burning in the incorporated limits of Mapleton City.

1. This permit is issued for burning ditch banks, fence lines or canals, only.
2. A written permit must be obtained from the Mapleton City Office prior to the start of the burning. This permit is valid only on the date issued. Office hours are 8:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday & 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Friday.
3. Open burning is permissible only if Utah County has determined the Clearing Index is satisfactory on the date the permit is issued.
4. Applicant for such permit must be in legal control of the ditch banks, fence lines or canals, where the burning is to be done.
5. Burning shall not be permitted when there is an appreciable wind. If a burn permit has been issued and the wind becomes a factor, applicant is responsible to not burn or put the fire out.
6. Such burning is done at a distance of more than 50 feet from any building, structure or other combustible waste matter.
7. Flammable or combustible liquids cannot be used to start or maintain a fire. Old tires cannot be used as a fuel source.
8. No petroleum or plastic products, cardboard or scrap lumber may be burned at any time.
9. A garden hose, water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment must be on hand and a competent person (age 16 or older) is in constant attendance until all fire has been extinguished.
