REQUEST

Robyn Metler requests approval of a Home Occupation Permit for Red Robyn Preschool located at 425 East 1300 North in the RA-2 Zone.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. Home occupations that involve clientele visiting the business must be approved by the Planning Commission (see Mapleton City Code 18.84.380(G)(3)).
2. The Planning Commission may attach conditions to the Home Occupation Permit which relate to “*health, safety and quality of the residential environment*” (see Mapleton City Code 18.84.380(E): Planning Commission May Attach Conditions).
3. The Applicant is requesting approval of a home occupation permit for a preschool, with 12 students proposed (see Attachment #1 – Home Occupation Permit Application for more information). One employee is proposed. Entrance is proposed from the rear basement entrance to the home.
4. An inspection by the Fire Inspector is still pending.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

1. According to the plans submitted by the Applicant, the total living area of the home is approximately 3,569 square feet. According to the plan, the room to be used for the home occupation is approximately 513.78 square feet, or approximately 14.4% of the home. Mapleton City Code 18.84.380(D)(3) states: “*The home occupation shall occupy not more than the equivalent of twenty five percent (25%) of the living area of the dwelling or five hundred (500) square feet, whichever is less. This shall also apply to detached structures.*” It is the opinion of Staff that not more than 500 square feet should be used for the home occupation.
2. Mapleton City Code 18.84.380(D)(7) states: “*Not more than six (6) cars (including those owned by the resident family) may be parked at the residence at any one time and such vehicles shall be parked within the driveway or in front of the residence. Clients of the home occupation shall not park or store vehicles at the premises overnight.*” It is the opinion of Staff that the intent of this ordinance section is to limit the number of cars outside the garage to no more than six.
3. Mapleton City Code 18.84.380(D)(11) states: “*Entrance to the home occupation from outside shall be through the same entrance normally used by the residing family except when a separate entrance may be required by regulation of the state health department or other public agency. The garage door shall not be used to satisfy this requirement.*” The Fire Department Inspector may determine whether the rear door entrance to the basement is the preferable entrance for safety.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff recommends approval of the home occupation with Conditions.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

1. Not more than 500 square feet shall be used for the home occupation.
2. The maximum number of vehicles to be parked outside the home shall be 6 at any one time.
3. Inspection for the home occupation must be passed by the Fire Inspector.
4. The proposed rear entrance must be approved by the Fire Inspector, otherwise the front door shall be used.
5. Occupancy limits shall not exceed those specified by International Fire Code, as determined by the Fire Inspector.
6. That the Applicant comply with all other requirements of Mapleton City Code 18.84.380: HOME OCCUPATIONS.

ALTERNATIVE ACTIONS:

1. The Planning Commission may Deny the Home Occupation Permit. Reasons for denial should be stated in the motion.
2. Continue to a Future Meeting Date: This action could be based upon findings that additional information is required prior to rendering a decision or to further consider information.

To Whom It May Concern:

I am interested in obtaining a business liscensed to run a preschool from my home. The name of the preschool will be Red Robyn Preschool. I will take up to 12 children. I taught 1st and 2nd grade for Provo School District and now I want to run my own preschool. I graduated from BYU in Elementary Education. There will always be 2 teachers at preschool. I am there every day and then I have a parent volunteer each day. Tuition is \$85 a month and preschool will run October through May. I will only teach one session of preschool. School will run from 9:30 am to 12:00 pm on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. I attended a class at the Bureau of Childcare Licensing in Provo. They told me that if children were in my home less than 4 hours a day I didn't need to get a state license. Preschool is only 2 ½ hours, 3 days a week. The schedule will be as follows:

9:30-10:00	Question of the day and self-start
10:00 – 10:45	Free play and snack
10:45 – 11:15	Circle time/calendar/sharing
11:15-11:45	Centers
11:45 – 12:00	Music

Parents will park on the south and west side of my house, going with the flow of traffic. No one will park in the drive way. That way they don't have to back up and risk injury to a child. When preschool ends, I will walk the children outside and wait by my garage, walking each student to their vehicle. Parents will provide the daily snack. I will ask that it be store bought and not too sugary.

In addition to basic preschool curriculum (abc's, numbers, colors, shapes) I will also include: fine motor skills, fine arts, classical music, movement and rhythm, poetry, and geography. I love teaching and I am very excited to be starting my own preschool. I have had neighbors begging me for years to do this. Thank you for your consideration in this.

Policies and Guidelines

1. **Registration:** A \$40.00 registration fee will be due by DATE. This is a non-refundable fee to be used for preschool supplies. The forms (yellow paper) and registration fee may be mailed or dropped off at Miss Robyn's house. If I don't have your form by the 13th, I will assume your child is not attending Red Robyn Preschool.
2. **Tuition:** The tuition payment of \$85.00 a month is due by the 5th of each month. Tuition is calculated by the number of days we are in session during the year and is divided into 9 equal payments. **Please make checks payable to Robyn Metler.** The bank will not take a check made out to Red Robyn Preschool.
 - a. If your child is enrolled after school has begun, tuition will be prorated for the current month only-the following payments will be \$85 per month. No tuition adjustments will be made for vacations, illnesses, holidays, etc.
 - b. Any tuition payment made after the 5th of the month will need to include an additional \$5 late fee. If late payment arrangements are not made with me by the 10th of the month, your child may be subject to dismissal.
3. **Additional Fees:** An additional fee may be assessed if your child arrives at preschool more than 5 minutes before or is picked up more than 5 minutes after a regularly scheduled session. Having each child arrive and leave on time is very important to the success of our preschool.
4. **Illnesses:** Children who show evidence of being ill at school will be isolated until the parent can return for them. If you think your child may be contagious, PLEASE KEEP THEM HOME THAT DAY.
5. Each child enrolled must be potty trained before being accepted in Red Robyn Preschool. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. Please don't let your child bring toys from home to preschool.






