

Mayor's Message

Urban Deer

In order to help answer any questions that you may have regarding our upcoming Urban Deer Program, I have asked Staff to hold a Public Open House on Wednesday, April 13th from 4:30 to 6:30 pm at the City Center located at 125 West 400 North. At the Public Open House we will discuss the new plan and how it will improve safety on city roads and Hwy 89, reduce deer numbers within city limits, reduce property damage caused by urban deer, and promote safe and cost effective deer removal.

New Ambulance

We are excited about the purchase of a new ambulance. Since 2010 Mapleton City has experienced a 34% increase in emergency responses. Prior to the purchase of the new ambulance the Mapleton City EMS Department responded with, and maintained two ambulances (1997 two wheel drive and a 2000 four wheel drive). Both vehicles have served our community well but need to be replaced to ensure efficient, effective, and safe emergency response to the citizens we serve. Over the past 18 month both ambulances have begun experiencing numerous mechanical and electrical maintenance issues which have led to increased maintenance costs and more importantly out of service time.

Residential Spring Clean-Up

In an effort to help accommodate each of you with your spring clean-up Mapleton City will provide dumpsters from April 21st through May 1st. The dumpsters will be located on the southeast corner of 300 West and 400 North (west of City Hall). Please enter off of 300 West Street. Do NOT drop off concrete or hazardous waste materials. Public Safety

During the 2015 year the Police Department fielded 509 animal related complaints from residents. A majority of those complaints were about dogs running loose in the streets or neighborhoods. As a reminder, Mapleton City Ordinance reads: "All dogs over four (4) months of age owned, possessed or harbored by any person in the city shall be registered with the city and a tag shall be issued upon payment of a fee approved by the city." In addition to being required by law to register your dog, it also gives the officers the ability to locate dog owners quickly and, in most cases, return the dog to the owner instead of taking it to the animal shelter.

On Saturday, April 16th from 10am-12pm the Mapleton Police Department is sponsoring a low cost licensing and rabies clinic at the Public Safety Building (305 North Main Street). This is a great opportunity to have your dog receive vaccinations and be licensed at a lowered price. Please refer to the included insert for times and pricing.

Public Works

Pressurized Irrigation

Weather permitting the City will be turning on the Pressurized Irrigation (PI) system between April 4th and April 15th. Please make sure that you are in compliance with the city code on your pressurized irrigation connection. The city requires that each user provides and installs a valve independent of the city's shut off valve that the user can control the pressurized irrigation to their premises. It is against city code for a person to tamper with or operate the city's shut off valve. (Mapleton City Code Section 13.30.090) Also, be aware that a cross connection between the pressurized irrigation system and the culinary water system is in violation of State and Municipal Code (Mapleton City Code Section 13.30, Class B misdemeanor). Connection to a secondary water source, such as pressurized irrigation, requires a physical air gap, not just a valve between the secondary and culinary systems. As part of our Cross Connection Program, and for public awareness, we do periodic checks on the system.
