## Utilities

### Garbage Collection

Garbage collection is on Monday. Please have cans out by 7am regardless. Some residents need to have their cans moved across the street to ensure their garbage is collected. If you have followed these guidelines for pickup and the can was not emptied, you should contact Republic Services at 801-785- 5935 before 3 PM the day after your regular pickup day, to schedule them to come back. If notification regarding a missed container is made after that time, Republic Services will not be able to return until the next scheduled pick up day. Garbage collection is affected by the holiday schedule from the Transfer Station:

- Memorial Day – May 29, 2017 pick up one day late
- Labor Day – September 4, 2017 pick up one day late
- Christmas Day – December 25, 2017 pick up one day late
- New Year's Day – January 1, 2018 pick up one day late
- All other holidays are normal collection days

Additional Garbage Cans: Contact the Utility Billing Office at 801-489-5655 to request additional garbage cans. The charge is listed on our Utility Rates page at [www.mapleton.org](http://www.mapleton.org). Additional cans must be kept at least 3 months.
