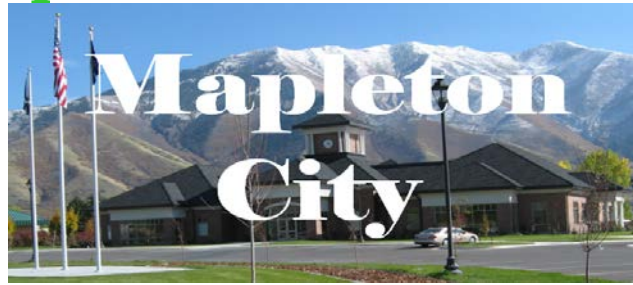

The Rabies and Licensing Clinic will be held behind City Hall at 125 West 400 North. The cost of the Rabies shot is \$12. There will also be other shots available for Parvo, Feline Distemper, and Feline Leukemia combo. Please make sure that your dogs are on a leash and your cats are contained. We will take checks, cash or credit card. All dogs must have current rabies vaccination before a license will be issued.
