REQUEST

To consider a resolution designating and appointing poll workers and their alternates to serve in the 2015 Municipal General Election.

BACKGROUND AND PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. Pursuant to Utah State Code Section 20A-5-602 sets forth the procedure of appointing poll workers and their alternates for the 2015 Municipal General Election.
2. The persons named as poll works and alternates are attached in Exhibit A.
3. The compensation shall be set according to Utah County's poll worker payment schedule and cannot exceed \$175.00.

Staff recommends approval of the proposed poll workers and the alternates and their compensation.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAPLETON, UTAH DESIGNATING AND APPOINTING POLL WORKERS AND THEIR ALTERNATES TO SERVE IN THE 2015 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 20A-5-602, Utah State Code, sets forth the procedure for appointing poll workers and their alternates, designating their compensation and setting forth their duties; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Mapleton City, Utah desires to make the appointments, set their compensation and provide for other matters relating to them.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Mapleton City, Utah as follows:

Section 1. Appointment of Poll Workers and Alternates. The persons named as poll workers and alternates on the list attached hereto (Exhibit A) are hereby appointed to serve in the Municipal Elections. The list contains the names and addresses, and telephone number of all such persons appointed are available upon request.

Section 2. Availability of Poll Workers List. The list attached hereto shall be available at the City Recorder's Office for inspection and examination during business hours by any voter of the City and any voter may make a copy of it.

Section 3. Compensation. The poll workers or alternates shall receive no more than \$175.00 for the November 3, 2015, Municipal General Election.
