REQUEST

To consider a resolution authorizing the surplus of the 1989 Ford Van, also known as the CERT van.

BACKGROUND AND DESCRIPTION

Mapleton City currently owns a 1989 Ford Cutaway Van that was previously used as the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) supply van. The original idea was to use the van to respond to incidents so that both people and supplies could be transported to a scene.

Mapleton City is currently re-organizing its CERT team and a new CERT director has been in place since March of 2016. The CERT director and I both agree that the CERT van no longer meets the needs of the city because of both mechanical and logistical problems. The current CERT van is in need of several mechanical repairs that would be quite costly. We feel that the needs of the CERT team would be better met with an enclosed trailer that any member can use to pull supplies to a scene. If approved, the funds from the sale of the CERT van would be used toward the purchase of a CERT enclosed trailer.
